



2010 Democracy Scholarship

The Kohler Credit Union is making available up to four \$4,000 scholarships (\$1,000 renewable for up to 3 years for a total of \$4,000) to graduating seniors whose high school records show outstanding achievement in the areas of scholarship, character, leadership, citizenship, and involvement in school and community activities.

The following are the minimum requirements:

1. Student or parents must have been Kohler Credit Union members prior to the beginning of this school year (*defined as September 1, 2009*).
2. Student must have a cumulative grade point in high school of at least 3.25 (*on a 4-point scale*), or equivalent.
3. Students must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in college (*on a 4-point scale*) to qualify for renewable portions of scholarship.
4. Student must have definite plans to attend a 4-year college or university in Wisconsin.
5. Student's high school record must indicate achievement and high standards in scholarship, character, leadership, citizenship, and involvement in school and community activities.
6. Finalists will participate in an interview at Kohler Credit Union.
7. The attached application must be completely filled out, signed, and returned to any of our branches by March 31, 2010. If the application is to be mailed, send to:
