Kohler Credit Union Opens Branch in North High School

Sheboygan, Wis. – September 15, 2008 – Kohler Credit Union, in partnership with Sheboygan School District officials, has opened an in-school branch at North High School. The full-service branch, which opened on September 2, is open to students and faculty.

The branch is operated by North High School student tellers, who were selected after a formal application and interview process, and a Kohler Credit Union in-school branch coordinator. In addition to working at the in-school branch, the student tellers will work at another full-service credit union branch. The branch is open during lunch periods, Monday through Friday.

“Kohler Credit Union is excited to partner with the Sheboygan School District in expanding our financial literacy program to Sheboygan North High School, “ says Cheryl Burton, Vice President of Member Operations at Kohler Credit Union. “The in-school branch gives student tellers the opportunity to gain knowledge of working within a financial institution and provides the student body with the opportunity to learn best practices in regards to their financial needs prior to going off to college or pursuing other endeavors. “

The North High School branch is not the first school-based financial literacy program for Kohler Credit Union. An in-school branch at South High School was opened in September of 2005, and the credit union is providing financial services to Riverview Academy students twice a week through the use of its mobile branch. Kohler Credit Union also participates in Junior Achievement and offers various classroom presentations on financial literacy and business skills through their speakers’ bureau.

Kohler Credit Union is a community chartered credit union with membership open to anyone who lives or works in Sheboygan, Ozaukee, Washington, Calumet, Fond du Lac and Manitowoc Counties. Established in 1938, Kohler Credit Union has over 31,000 members and assets of \$225 million.
